WHEREAS, in July, 2021, the Authority acquired the property located at One Holbrook Place, Ansonia, Connecticut, using a loan from Ion Bank in the original principal amount of \$562,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the Ion Bank loan provided for an eighteen (18) month period of interest only payments during the construction period; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the improvement work is more extensive than originally anticipated, and taking longer to complete; and

WHEREAS, as a result there is a need to extend the interest only period of the Ion Bank loan from eighteen (18) months to twenty-four months, and modify the amortization period for full principal and interest payments from twenty-five (25) years to twenty-four (24) years and six (6) months; and

WHEREAS, this resolution is to authorize the modification and authorize the Executive Director o execute and deliver the document with Ion Bank to effectuate the foregoing;
